What is CDP data used for?

90%

of large purchasing organizations are engaging their suppliers on improving environmental performance, including through environmental disclosure, with an additional 9% planning to do so soon.

Purchasing organizations use CDP data to **benchmark suppliers** year-on-year and assess a company's performance against their peers.

Some purchasers use CDP data as part of supplier evaluations and performance reviews.
