IPG's filament tapes are used in meat, poultry and fish processing plants, which typically have damp, humid working conditions. The corrugated Gaylord containers in these plants are normally lined with poly bags and re-used multiple times. The weight of the contents and moisture in the air causes additional stress on the corrugated. Wrapping the Gaylord multiple times with filament tape helps minimize a condition called "elephant footing". Without the tape to reinforce the container it would start to bulge out near the bottom. Filament tape is used to hold the poly bags in place, plus provide longevity to the corrugated containers.

Typical applications include:

- Combo bins (RG300, RG303)
- Holding Gaylord liners in place (RG286, 199)
- Reinforcement of Gaylords (RG300, RG303)
- General bundling (RG286, 199)
- General reinforcement (RG286, RG300, RG303, 199)
- Temporary holding of plastic bags (197)
- L-clipping (RG317, RG319)
